Lead poisoning can occur at any age. The consequences of lead poisoning that we can observe during childhood, may also persist into late adulthood.

This conference will begin with a presentation on what we can learn from assessing blood and bone lead levels. Dr. Howard Hu will present.

Next, Dr. Morri Markowitz will present a broad overview of lead sources, followed by an outline of the mechanisms of toxicity and treatment of childhood lead poisoning.

Adults are also sensitive to lead. Dr. Michael Kosnett will discuss whether current laws are protective.

The conference will close with a discussion of the financial consequences of lead poisoning from the perspective of earnings and costs to society, presented by Dr. Janet Currie.
